Dr. Amy Harris is a graduate program director and associate professor in the Department of Information Systems and Analytics at Middle Tennessee State University (MTSU). Her primary research interest is workforce development, with a particular emphasis on IT talent development and gender representation in tech. Harris is active in the Nashville tech community. She serves as President of Women in Technology Tennessee, on the steering committee for the Nashville Analytics Summit, and as a member of the Greater Nashville Technology Council's (NTC) Diversity and Inclusion Committee. She was recognized by the NTC in 2019 as the Nashville Technology Council's "Champion of the Year" and again in 2021 as their "Diversity and Inclusion Advocate of the Year." She is also a recipient of the MTSU Jones College of Business E.W. "Wink" Midgett Distinguished Service Award.
